Year 9	<p>With emphasis on <u>thinking skills, managing information, working with others, communication and using ICT</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to ask a friend’s name and give their own; learn the numbers 0-12; learn the names of the countries; learn to say where they live; learn the German alphabet and to spell in German; name items in a school bag; learn to say what they have and ask their friends what they have got; learn colours; understand what the teacher says; learn the numbers 13-31; learn the days of the week and talk about dates; learn to say what age they are and ask what age a friend is.</p>	<p>Focusing on <u>using mathematics, communication, thinking skills and managing information and working with others</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to say what school subjects they study; learn to ask friends about their timetables; learn to ask for and give opinions about school subjects; learn to talk about favourite subjects; learn numbers up to 60; learn to ask and give time; learn to ask and explain when things start; learn to ask for help in the classroom; discuss what they eat and drink at breaktime; learn to talk about what they wear to school.</p>	<p>With attention to <u>oral and written communication, working with others, being creative, self-management, managing information, thinking and problem-solving</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to talk about their brothers and sisters; learn to talk about pets; learn to describe people; learn to ask about a friend’s family and learn to talk about their own family; learn to ask people about their characteristics; understand a longer letter and learn to write a letter.</p>	<p>With emphasis on <u>managing information, problem-solving, thinking skills, oral and written communication, using mathematics, and working with others</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to ask someone which sport they like and explain which sport they like; learn to ask a friend about hobbies and talk about your hobbies; learn to ask what people like or dislike doing and also say what people like/dislike doing; understand short texts about others; learn to arrange a date with a friend; learn to ask a friend about his or her favourite things; consolidate previous vocabulary.</p>	<p>Focusing on <u>using mathematics, using ICT, managing information, problem-solving, working with others and communication</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to ask a friend where he/she lives and explaining where they live exchange addresses and telephone numbers; learn to say what you do in your house; learn to say how you help around the house and be able to ask a friend how they help around the house; learn to discuss what you have in your room and ask a friend what they have in their room; describe where things are and ask where things are; give an extended description of their home and what you do there.</p>	<p>With attention to <u>using mathematics, being creative, working with others, thinking skills, managing information and communication</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to ask about a town and discuss their own town; learn to ask what you do in town and say what you can do in town; discuss playing a game with a friend; understand counting to 100 and ordering some food and drink at an ice-cream café; learn to ask a friend what snack foods they like and explain what snack foods they like; discuss about how they learn German and talk about practicing German.</p>

Year 10	<p>With emphasis on <u>thinking, problem-solving, working with others, using ICT and communication</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: ask for and give personal details; learn present tense; learn weather; learn and understand classroom phrases; learn perfect tense; learn how to express time.</p>	<p>With attention to <u>thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, using mathematics, using ICT and working with others</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn to talk about a recent holiday and the European countries; learn to talk about methods of transport; learn to say where they went on holiday and where you stayed; learn activities on holidays and school trips; learn to buy train tickets; learn the language regarding lost property; understand postcard writing.</p>	<p>Focusing on <u>managing information, thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, using ICT and communication</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: learn the parts of the body; learn the common ailments; learn to explain symptoms and understand the doctor’s advice; learn to talk about how to keep fit; learn to communicate regarding daily routine; understand a report about a busy activity week</p>	<p>With emphasis on <u>using mathematics, using ICT, working with others, communication, thinking, problem-solving and decision making</u>.</p> <p>Pupils will: talk about what they had for breakfast; talk about what they like and do not like eating; discuss buying fruit and vegetables at the market; talk about where the shops are; talk about which shops they are going to and which shops they are in; discuss what they do with their pocket money.</p>
